GENERAL INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS:

TAKE 680 SOUTH TO ALUM ROCK AVENUE ... YOU WILL WANT TO GO EAST ON ALUM ROCK, TOWARDS THE MOUNTAINS FOLLOW ALUM ROCK YOU WILL CROSS CAPITOL AVE ABOUT 3/4 MILE LATER YOU WILL COME TO WHITE RD....TURN LEFT ON WHITE ROAD (JAMES LICK HIGH SCHOOL WILL BE ON YOUR LEFT).....GO ABOUT A QUARTER MILE TO HYLAND AVENUE (which should be the first street you come to...the sign was missing last year)...TURN RIGHT ON HYLAND AVENUE...FOLLOW...YOU WILL FIND THE SCHOOL AND THE CHURCH ON THE LEFT.

The Courtyard Stage (vocalists) is located in the lot across from the rides. The stage is next to the Parish Hall. It is very easy to find. Since all of you performed therein a past year, you will remember. The Main Stage (bands) is located behind the School.

You will have to park where you can. Parking may be a problem, as people will park on the streets and then walk to the Fiesta. One side of the street has the carnival rides. We are on the opposite side of the street where the School and Church are.

DRESS, DRESSING AREA:

There are usually dressing tents near the stage. Look ready to rock and make a visual as well as an audio impression on your audience!! LOOK NICE....LOOK VERY NICE. For bands, look like you are in a 'rock band'. LOOK PROFESSIONAL!!!

P A SYSTEM:

PA system is being provided for us, as well as 2 guitar amps, a bass amp and full drum set. We will be using, just, our keyboards, pedal boards and small accessories. Members will need to bring their own guitars, straps, drumsticks, etc. The drum set is a brand new DW!!

MISCEL:

This will be our 18th year at this Fiesta. This is where I went to school from First through Eighth grades. This show has special meaning to me....I am sure that we will put on a great show. The weather might be suspect, so be ready. If it rains on Thursday and/or Friday be aware of a wet field.

This Fiesta is open to the public, so guests are more than welcome. There is no charge to get in. This is one off the largest School/Church Festivals in Northern California. There is a separate mid way for carnival rides, etc.
